Smart911.com

Smart911: is designed for everyone whether they have special needs or not. Information is tied to the individual's phone number and becomes immediately available to dispatchers if the individual calls 911.

Under this program, individuals can create free, secure profiles <u>https://www.smart911.com/</u> that contain information about medical conditions, medications, allergies, the number of children in a house, pets and more. *"We encourage everyone to take 10 minutes out of their day to create a profile. It could save your life, or the lives of your family members and pets."* said Commissioner Doug Hoke.

By filling out a profile, people can alert emergency responders in advance of a variety of different critical information, including:

- The layout of the family home, which could help responders search for loved ones in case of a fire or other emergency
- Mobility problems that could hinder a family member's ability to escape in case of fire
- Emergency contacts responders can call in case of an emergency
- Specific allergies or medical conditions within a household

- The medications an individual is taking
- A family member's physical/mental or developmental disability

<u>Individuals with special needs must register for each list independently</u> for the proper notifications to be delivered to the appropriate parties in the event of an emergency.

Plan For Any Emergency

The Special Needs Registry is designed for major disasters and natural emergencies. When households sign up for this registry they are only notified by law enforcement or first responders in the event of a major incident that requires evacuation of a specific area. Households on this registry are checked during these major emergencies to ensure all residents have been both notified and assisted in the evacuation to a safe area.
